## **Move to Common-Law Court**

Establish the flesh and blood from the fiction. Convert the Judge from a minister to a Judge.

A Judge can only hear fact from a flesh and blood man. A Judge cannot order a flesh and blood man to do ANYTHING.

In swearing in or introduction, state your name, spell it upper-lower case, as the flesh and blood authorized agent for the "state your name" all-capital letters fiction, and we are both present your Honor. Then before proceeding, ask the Court 3 questions:

- For the record your Honor, does "Judges name" have a Oath of Office on record?
  For the record your Honor, does "Judges name" have an Oath of Office on record in the courtroom?
- 3. For the record your Honor, will this Court take judicial notice of "Judges name" Oath of Office?

The Answer to No.1 will be yes.

The Answer to No.2 will probably be no.

The Answer to No.3 will be yes.

Now you have established the flesh and blood man dealing with the judge and NOT a minister.

Also, due to the fact that it is "assumed and presumed" that attorneys are under oath, their every word is assumed to be truth... so you should add:

"My name is.... and I wish to state the following for the record, that my every utterance in this courtroom today shall be made of my own certain knowledge, shall be true, and made under the pain and penalty of perjury."

This gives your words the same weight as any attorney/lawyer. Before you do this it isn't likely that anything you say will be assumed to hold any truth... just the opposite. And the appearance of truth is KEY.
